Dear David,

A great deal of time and prayer has been spent discussing your relationship to the Seventh-day Adventist church. As your statement of intention did not include a willingness to cooperate with General Conference working policy K 05 05 6, your ministry was discussed with an officer group at the 2013 Spring Meeting.

The officer group decided that a letter would go out to General Conference officers, departments and institutions, all divisions and MENA indicating we cannot endorse your ministry and that we are discouraging churches and church units from working with you. The letter indicates that you are not to be invited by any entity of the church as you are unwilling to cooperate and work in harmony with the church. The letter also states that your relationship with the church could be reexamined if you submit to the General Conference, in writing, a willingness to fully comply with General Conference Working Policy K 05 05 6.

The letter has been prepared and is ready to be sent from the president's office. However, the letter has not been sent as we want to provide you a final opportunity to express a willingness to fully cooperate with General Conference Working Policy K 05 05 6. We find no joy in sending a letter as described in the previous paragraph as we all recognize the serious consequences of such a letter. We would like to embrace you as a brother and view GMI as a supportive ministry. Please, please respond in the spirit of cooperation. If I do not receive your written intention to comply with General Conference Working Policy K 05 05 6 on or before May 24, 2013, the letter will be sent from the office of the president.

David, you will be in our prayers. May God bless you with a clear mind and a cooperative spirit.
